
PLAYING MUSIC IS MORE THAN JUST MEMORIZING A BUNCH OF CHORDS ON YOUR INSTRUMENT.

That's difficult. And takes a long time.

MOVING BETWEEN CHORDS

- Moving between chords should be
 - Efficient
 - Use minimal hand movement
 - Done without looking at your hand
- Use sequences that plant fingers so that that you always know where your fingers are in relation to the fret board
 - "Walk your fingers"
- In most modern music, there are only a handful of sequences
 - Practice these and you'll have a much easier time playing songs you've never played before

COMMON CHORDS: KEY OF C




COMMON TRANSITIONS: KEY OF C

 $\begin{array}{cccc} C & \leftrightarrows & F \\ F & \leftrightarrows & G \\ C & \leftrightarrows & G \\ Am & \leftrightarrows & F \\ C & \leftrightarrows & G7 \\ F & \leftrightarrows & G7 \end{array}$

Of the 2,200 chord changes found in the ICDb songs, these few make up 44% of them


FINGER REFERENCE

- ϕo Pointer Finger
- **♦** → Middle Finger
- $\phi \rightarrow Pinky$
- $\phi \rightarrow \mathsf{Thumb}$
- → Unspecfied finger



C MAJOR ⇒ F MAJOR

- l. Plant pointer (1) on 3rd string
- 2. Plant middle (2) on 1st string
- 3. Lift ring (3) finger












F MAJOR \Rightarrow C MAJOR

- l. Plant ring (3) on 4th string
- 2. Lift other fingers










C MAJOR \Rightarrow G MAJOR

- Plant middle (2) on 4th string next to ring (3) (on 2nd fret)
- 2. Plant pointer (1) on 2nd string
- 3. Step ring (3) from 4th string to 3rd string (same fret)












G MAJOR \Rightarrow C MAJOR

- Lift pointer (1) finger
- 2. Step ring (3) from the 3rd string to the 4th string (same fret)
- 3. Lift middle (2) finger












F MAJOR ⇒ G MAJOR

- 1. Move middle (2) to 4th string 2nd fret
- 2. Move pointer (1) to 2nd string 2nd fret
- 3. Plant ring (3) on 3rd string 3rd












G MAJOR => F MAJOR

- 1. Move pointer (1) to 3rd string 1st fret
- 2. Move middle (2) to 1st string 2nd fret (lifting ring (3) finger at the same time)










C MAJOR \Rightarrow G DOM. 7^{TH}

- 1. Slide ring (3) on 4th string from the 3rd fret to the 2nd fret
- 2. Plant pointer (1) on 3rd string
- 3. Plant middle (2) on the 2^{nd} string













G DOM. 7™ ⇒ C MAJOR

- 1. Slide ring (3) on 4th string from the 2nd fret to the 3rd fret
- 2. Lift other fingers










G DOM. 7TH ⇒F MAJOR

- Step middle (2) from 2nd string to 1st string
- 2. Lift ring (3) finger










F MAJOR ⇒ G DOM. 7TH

- l. Plant ring (3) on 4th string
- 2. Step middle (2) from 1st string to 2nd string










A MINOR F MAJOR



 $Am \rightarrow F$

1. Plant pointer (1) finger on 3rd string

 $F \rightarrow Am$

1. Lift pointer (1) finger
